Understanding the Client's Aims

Getenergy Bridge Ltd commissioned UK NARIC to develop a bespoke database, providing information on the available qualifications and training structures in the upstream oil and gas industry from 24 countries across the world. The purpose of the database was to enable users, principally recruiters from major international oil and gas companies, to compare qualifications in the sector from one country to another.

The UK NARIC Approach

In partnership with Getenergy, UK NARIC compiled research into the oil and gas sector and education systems of the 24 countries, identifying recognised institutions, sector-specific training requirements, contact information for key personnel and the structure of the sector. UK NARIC then developed an innovative Global Qualification Mapper, utilising the UK NARIC Band Framework alongside an extensive dataset on international qualifications. To facilitate design of the database and validate the methodology, the project team drew upon the expertise from representatives from the industry's major players, working closely with senior recruiters from BP, Schlumberger and PTTEP Thailand throughout the course of the project.

Delivering Quality Results

The bespoke database enables recruiters to quickly find information about qualifications in the sector from one country to another. Providing a clear indication of comparability for national sectoral qualifications, the Global Qualification Mapper has enabled recruiters from around the world to make more informed decisions on applications from overseas trained workers in the oil and gas industry.
