Provision of International Qualifications Benchmarking Service for Non-Local Students

Understanding the Client's Aims

To inform their admissions requirements for international students, the VTC commissioned UK NARIC to identify the overseas qualifications and grades from 42 countries that were considered to meet the minimum entrance requirements to study VTC higher level vocational awards in Hong Kong.

The UK NARIC Approach

UK NARIC devised a dynamic methodology to produce the information requested. This involved examination of VTC's entrance requirements to ensure that appropriate qualifications were selected. This was followed by the identification and analysis of international qualifications meeting both the academic and English language proficiency requirements set by the VTC for local students.

Delivering Quality Results

The results of this study were presented to the VTC as a dataset, which they have used to inform their admissions process. In addition to this, UK NARIC has provided advice and guidance as part of the post-project consultation, where required.
